What is German Summer School?

Learning in the holidays? Yes, and it's fun! At German Summer School, children improve their German skills and build their confidence.



18 children are supervised by three teaching professionals. During the last week, the children stay overnight. Adequate food is provided for the entire duration.



Reading, writing, vocabular and grammar are practised with lots of games and tasks in German lessons.



During drama class, the children work on a play. At the end of the German Summer School, the parents watch the final result.



Of course, there is plenty of free time too. In the afternoons, there is time for crafts, sport and fun. The children get to know their city better on daytrips.
